

Minnesota Jaycees Charitable Foundation Chapter Grant Application



The Minnesota Jaycees Charitable Foundation sponsors grants to help chapter run quality projects.

The following criteria have been established for the grants:

- Projects will be selected based on community impact and/or furthering the Jaycee movement, as well as the quality of the PMG (Project Management Guide).
- Priority is given to first year projects.
- Projects submitted must be completed during the current Jaycee year.
- Grant amounts will not exceed the project budget and the grant money must only be used for the project described in the request. If the project is not completed, the grant funds must be returned.
- A final PMG will be required upon completion of the project. If a PMG is not received, chapters may not be considered for future grants.
- Grants submitted should be for a minimum of \$250.00, however, less than the full amount requested may be granted.
- Applications for a grant must include:
 - This application
 - An initial PMG, approved by the chapter board

Grant requests are considered and disbursed throughout the year. Application deadline for grants to be awarded at JCI Minnesota Spring All State Convention is **MARCH 31**
